Group Banker:

- The responsibility of the group banker is to ensure the that funds raised by the group are handled in line with the groups Standards of Practice set out by my AFK.
- Maintaining accurate records of the groups budget, including income and expenditure.
- Ensure reasonable expenses towards the cost of organising events are agreed in advance with the Events & Community Fundraising Manager.
- Ensure receipts are held from any group expenses and thank you cards are given where appropriate for donations.
