Set up an online fundraising page

The best way to kick start your fundraising is to set up an online giving page. This is a digital sponsorship form that makes it super easy for you to spread the word about your challenge and for your supporters to make a donation. You'll have your own web page to share, people can donate directly to it, and the money gets automatically sent to AFK. It takes all the hassle out of collecting donations so you can focus on your fabulous fundraising! We recommend using JustGiving but whatever platform your prefer is fine with us!

As a passionate fundraiser you probably have a lot to say about why you're doing your challenge for AFK. So, once you've set up your fundraising page let your supporters know why you're doing it and why they should get involved too!

Adding things like a photo, a story and a fundraising target will motivate people to support you further!



Spread the word
